## **Informal Consultation - B5018 Main Street, Branston Footway and Cycleway Improvement Scheme**

**Dear Sir or Madam,**

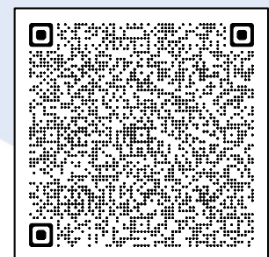
Following our previous consultation letter, we received feedback from the residents and key stakeholders regarding the proposal to make Church Road one-way. Based on these comments, we have decided not to go ahead with the one-way road plan and will instead retain the existing arrangements.

To accommodate this decision, we have made some changes to our proposal. Firstly, we have changed the proposed parallel crossing design to a raised zebra crossing on B5018 Main Street. Secondly, we will retain both existing bus lay-bys on B5018 Main Street adjacent to Church Road. Finally, we are proposing to slightly widen the existing footway into the carriageway on the eastern side of Church Road. However, due to these changes, it is now necessary for cyclists to dismount for a short distance between the proposed zebra crossing and the bus shelter located on the northern footway. On the southern side, the footway width will remain as it currently is.
